Scott County is looking for an experienced and qualified, landscape company to perform the following services:

- 1) Propose a two year (July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2014) prairie management plan indicating proposed strategies to:
  - a. Provide periodic services to eradicate invasive and noxious weeds;
  - b. Promote the growth and success of desirable prairie plant species;
  - c. Perform periodic raised mowing, burning, or other strategies to control growth and health of the prairie and manage undesirable growth;
  - d. Effectively maintain several bioswales, rain gardens and detention areas;
  - e. Achieve a mature natural prairie area that will:
    - i. Reduce site run-off
    - ii. Prevent erosion
    - iii. Present a pleasant appearance
    - iv. Provide natural cover for native small animals and birds
    - v. Continue to provide site value as intended with the LEED certification
- 2) Specifically describe the processes, tasks and strategies to achieve the above goals, including frequency;
- 3) Contractor should make all effort to minimize or eliminate (preferred) the application of chemicals in the maintenance of the prairie; herbicides may be used for spot treatment only;
- 4) Provide at least two references (including photos and contact information) of natural prairie areas the company is currently managing and maintaining;
- 5) Payments to be made in 8 equal monthly payments (July, August, September, October, March, April, May, June) for each year of the contract unless the contractor proposes other reasonable payment schedule; advance payment for services will NOT be considered;
- 6) Contractor must provide a monthly report with each payment request, outlining what work (if any) has been performed in prior period;
