

Scott County Agricultural Land Use Mapping RFP – Questions and Answers

Questions are in bold text, answers in blue.

Will historical hard copy maps be available to refer to during the project?

Hard copy (tax parcel) maps have not been maintained in recent years but may be useful and will be available as a resource if desired. We have scanned our hard copy tax parcel books and those files could be transferred to the successful vendor via FTP or some other means. Current GIS parcel data and other supporting layers will be made available in standard ESRI GIS format.

Will non-tillable land (under bullet 6) include waste, terraces and waterways?

Items to be included in non-crop land may be refined by the Ag Rule Committee. We are hopeful that the non-crop definition will be available before the start of the project.
