Scott County will receive single prime sealed bids for the 503 Scott Street Project, which consists of demolition of an existing house and garage and construction of a new maintenance facility at the same address. Bids will be accepted until 2:00 p.m. local time on December 3, 2014. Bids must be received at the Scott County Administrative Center 6<sup>th</sup> floor reception desk no later than 2:00 p.m. local time to be considered. The public bid opening will be held in Conference Room 605B at the same location. Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check payable to Scott County or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and an acceptable surety company authorized to do business in the state of Iowa in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the Base Bid.

Bids may not be withdrawn within sixty (60) days after the scheduled time of opening bids, without the consent of the Owner. The Owner reserves the right to accept any bid or to reject any or all bids, or parts of such bids, and waive informalities or irregularities in bidding.

Scott County reserves the right to reject any and / or all bids. Further, Scott County reserves the right to resolicit and/or re-bid this project at any time in the future.
