Scott County will receive sealed bids for Scott County Administrative Center Exterior Lighting Upgrades until 10:00 a.m. local time on May 27, 2015 at the Scott County Administrative Center, 600 West Fourth Street, Davenport, Iowa 52801-1030. Prospective Bidders are required by the Owner to register as an online vendor with Public Purchase at www.publicpurchase.com

This project includes: Selective demolition, construction and upgrades to several exterior lighting fixtures, wiring, bases and associated above and below ground improvements.

A pre-bid meeting will be held on Monday, May 18, 2015 at 9:30 a.m. beginning at the Scott County Administrative Center, Conference Room 605, 6th Floor, 600 W. 4th St., Davenport, IA 52801-1030. All prospective bidders are encouraged to attend this pre-bid meeting to discuss the scope of work, drawings, specifications and bid form. There will be an opportunity to ask questions of the engineer at that time.

Make proposals on the bid form supplied. Submit with each bid, bid security in the form of a certified check or acceptable bidder's bond payable to Scott County in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid. The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Labor and Material Payment Bond, and Performance Bond, both in the total bid amounts.

Bids may not be withdrawn within thirty (30) days after the scheduled time of opening bids, without the consent of the Owner. The Owner reserves the right to accept any bid or to reject any or all bids, or parts of such bids, and waive informalities or irregularities in bidding. Scott County reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids. Further, Scott County reserves the right to resolicit and/or re-bid this project at any time in the future.
