Any persons interested may appear and file objections to the proposed plans, specifications, form of contract, or cost of the improvements.

Notice is hereby given that the Scott County Conservation Board will hold a meeting at Conservation Board Room, Scott County Conservation Headquarters (Gate 3), 14810 110th Avenue, Davenport, IA 52804 at 3:00 P.M. Local Time September 16, 2020 at which time and place said Board shall review the bids for the construction of the proposed work and award the contract to the lowest responsive responsible bidder or set such subsequent time and place, as determined by the Board, for acting upon the bids and entering into a contract for the work.

The extent of work on this project is the furnishing of all labor, equipment, and materials for the construction of improvements generally described as follows:

Project consists of constructing gravity sewer and force main for park sanitary sewer system for the dump station and central service station, aerobic treatments system, septic tanks and associated mechanical, electrical and controls.
