## PART 2 – CONTRACTING REQUIREMENTS

1. **DELETE:** Subparagraph to Paragraph 15.01.C.2 Certified Payroll Requirements in Article 15 of the Supplementary General Conditions Page 11 of 12, strike through entire addition in the Project Manual. Certified Payrolls will not be required.

Add the following new subparagraph to Paragraph 15.01.C.2:

- d. Certified Payroll Requirements:
  - 1) Contractor and subcontractors on public works projects must submit certified payroll records on a monthly basis to the lowa Department of Labor Certified Payroll and a copy to the public body in charge of the project, along with a statement affirming that such records are true and accurate; that the wages paid to each worker are not less than the required rate, and that the Contractor is aware that filing records he or she knows to be false is a Class B misdemeanor.
  - 2) The certified payroll records must include for every worker employed on the public works project the name, address, telephone number, social security number, job classification, hourly wages paid in each pay period, number of hours worked each day, and starting and ending time of work each day. These certified payroll records are considered public records and public bodies must make these records available to the public under the Freedom of Information Act, with the exception of the employee's address, telephone number and social security number.
