All bids received after the above stipulated closing time for receipt of bids will be returned to the bidder unopened. All bids received in accordance with these guidelines will be publicly opened and read aloud in Conference Room 258 at the Scott County Courthouse – second floor. Prospective Bidders are required prior to the bid opening, by the Owner to register as an online vendor with Public Purchase at www.publicpurchase.com. Registration is at no cost to the vendor; however Public Purchase has several levels of membership and vendors may choose to subscribe to a plan that requires a subscription cost. All prints will be delivered through UPS Ground. Refunds will be given upon return of the full set of documents within fourteen days after award of the project. Documents must be returned to American Reprographics Company in a reusable condition or the deposit shall be forfeited.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held on Monday, June 1, 2026 at 1:00 p.m. beginning at the Scott County Courthouse Main Entrance, 400 W 4th Street. Project Architect will be on site for this meeting. This will be the only opportunity for Contractors to enter the building prior to bid opening.

Make proposals on the bid forms supplied in the Project Manual. No oral, telegraphic or telephonic proposals or modifications will be considered. Submit with each bid, a certified check or acceptable bidder's bond payable to Scott County in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total bid. The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Labor and Material Payment Bond, and Performance Bond.

Bids may not be withdrawn within forty-five (45) days after the scheduled time of opening bids, without the consent of the Owner. The Owner reserves the right to accept any bid or to reject any or all bids, or parts of such bids, and waive informalities or irregularities in bidding.

The Owner requires Substantial Completion of the project on or before November 6, 2026.

Scott County reserves the right to reject any and / or all bids. Further, Scott County reserves the right to resolicit and/or re-bid this project at any time in the future.
