Re: Non-Deductibility of Lobbying Expenses Required Notification

**Dear County Auditor:** 

Enclosed is your FY2026 ISAC membership certificate. I want to take this opportunity to thank you for your support during the past year.

The Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1993 (H.R. 2264) requires us to inform our members of the percentage of membership dues utilized for lobbying expenses. ISAC's expenses for lobbying activities were approximately 60.4% of the dues collected from our membership during FY-2025. We estimate that percentage will be approximately 63.8% for FY-2026.

The reason for reporting this information is that under federal law, federal income taxpayers are no longer allowed to deduct lobbying expenses. We realize that counties do not pay federal income tax, but the law contains no exceptions for associations made up of political subdivisions. And under the law, if an association fails to report lobbying expenses or dues nondeductibility to members as part of their dues assessment, the association is subject to federal penalties. So out of an excess of caution, we are including this information.
