

February 17, 2010 Minutes of the Scott County Conference Board

- The Scott County Conference Board met this 17th day of February in the Room 638 of the Scott County Administrative Center, 600 W. 4th St., Davenport, Iowa. The meeting was called for the purpose of approving and adopting the combined budget for the County Assessor's Office for the 7/1/2010 to 6/30/2011 fiscal year, and to act upon any other necessary business that may come before the Board.

- A motion to accept, as presented, the minutes of the January 28, 2010 meeting was made by Freemire and seconded by Liske. The motion passed unanimously.
- The Assessor presented the Proof of Publication Notice for the 2010-2011 FY Budget published in the Quad City Times, February 5, 2010.
- The Assessor gave a brief overview of the budget including 2% salary increase with no increase in the health costs.
- The Public Hearing on the 2010-2011 FY Budget was opened at 3:03 p.m. by Chair Gallin. With no correspondence received and no public present, the Public Hearing was closed at 3:04 p.m. on a motion by Liske and a second by Crockett. The motion carried unanimously.
- The Board on a motion by Liske and a second by Lane then voted on the 2010-2011 Combined Budget as presented. A roll call vote was taken with all members present voting yes.

Supervisor Larry Minard asked Dale Denklau if there were any new value trends this year in assessments and Dale explaining there aren't any new trends. Supervisor Tom Sunderbruch said that they told the Farm Bureau that Dale would come out to explain Ag Land values.
