

Scott County Board of Supervisors
June 2, 2026 8:31 a.m.

The Board of Supervisors met as a committee of the whole and pursuant to adjournment with Beck, Dickson, Maxwell, and Paustian present. Bribiesco joined online.

Engineer Angie Kersten reviewed the 28E Intergovernmental Agreement between Scott County and the City of Davenport for the E. 90th Street Pavement Reconstruction Project No. 35061/PRJ-4432. Kersten reviewed the project that was awarded to Midwest Concrete, Inc. and Scott County will be responsible for fifty percent of the construction costs. Supervisors reviewed the language in the 28E Agreement. County Administrator Mahesh Sharma reviewed any questions or concerns will be addressed for the Thursday vote.

Kersten reviewed the contract for construction of HMA resurfacing with cold in-place recycling project on F45 (240th Street) from 180th Avenue to 240th Avenue. Kersten reviewed there were six (6) bids with Valley Construction Co. with the low bid. Supervisor Bribiesco reviewed the language in the resolution. Supervisor Maxwell stated any questions or concerns will be addressed for the Thursday vote.

Kersten reviewed the request of an additional expenditure of \$24,239 for the PCC pavement patching project on 210th Street. Supervisor Bribiesco reviewed the memorandum and completion of the project. Chairman Maxwell stated the resolution will have a vote on Thursday as written.

Kersten reviewed the FY27 road rock and ice control sand pricing. She reviewed multiple quarries including Riverstone Group, Inc, Linwood Mining, and Wendling Quarries will be used in the resolution.

Kersten reviewed the FY27 purchase of snow and ice control salt. Kersten reviewed Compass Minerals America, Inc submitted the lowest responsive bid.

GIS Manager Ray Weiser reviewed a three (3) year contract renewal of the Scott County/Davenport Beacon parcel site with Schneider Geospatial. Weiser reviewed the annual cost sharing between Scott County, Davenport City Assessor, and County Assessor and the new additions to the service. Supervisors reviewed the memorandum. Chairman Maxwell stated any questions and concerns will be addressed for the Thursday vote.

County Administrator Mahesh Sharma removed the resolution for further review of a one (1) year contract with Governmentjobs.com, Inc. in the amount \$40,917.29 for NeoGov HR suite subscription.

Sharma reviewed tax suspension requests.

MEDIC EMS Director Paul Andorf reviewed the contract renewal with Dr. Vermeer. Andorf reviewed Iowa Administrative Code 641, Chapter 132, requires each EMS service program to have a Medical Director.

MEDIC EMS Director Paul Andorf reviewed the MEDIC EMS ambulance service agreement with Durant.

Sheriff Tim Lane reviewed a two (2) year 28E Agreement with Eastern Iowa Community College for full-time (40-hrs a week) Deputy as the liaison deputy between EICC and SCC Belmont Campus and the Sheriff's Office.

Treasurer Tony Knobbe reviewed the abatement request from the City of LeClaire. Knobbe reviewed a designated area that will become a sidewalk.

Planning and Development Director Greg Schaapveld reviewed a discussion of the Princeton URA letter. Schaapveld reviewed a consultation meeting involving TIF with the Winding Hills 2nd Subdivision.

Director of Budgeting and Finances David Farmer reviewed a discussion of Quarterly Budgeting for Outcomes Report. Farmer highlighted several departments including Community Services, Health, MEDIC, SECC, Sheriff, and Treasurer. Supervisors reviewed Community Services, Health Department, and Visit Quad Cities. Community Services Director Lori Elam reviewed updates within Community Services.

Farmer reviewed a discussion of Quarterly Financial Summary Report of Actual Revenues and Expenditures.

Farmer reviewed quarterly financial reports from various county offices.

County Administrator Mahesh Sharma reviewed Four (4) tobacco license renewals for FY27: NAAZ Group LLC, 11423 160th St., Davenport, Perfect Value Liquor Mart, 5 Lincoln Ave STE B, Eldridge, Express Lane Gas & Food Mart Inc., 17948 Great River Rd., Pleasant Valley, and Big 10 Mart #22, 20919 N. Brady St., Davenport.

Supervisor Bribriesco expressed her concerns regarding the closed session.
