

Scott County Board of Supervisors
July 14, 2026 8:30 a.m.

The Board of Supervisors met as a committee of the whole and pursuant to adjournment with Maxwell, Paustian, Beck, Bribiesco, and Dickson present.

Linda Golinghorst, 24669 Allens Grove Rd, Dixon, addressed the board on intervening with the IUC docket on the Hickory Grove Generation Station by CIPCO.

Molly Regan, 1023 Holmes Street, Bettendorf, addressed the board on intervening in the IUC hearing on docket #GCU-2026-0001 involving CIPCO.

Jerry Moore, 23785 130th avenue, Eldridge, addressed the board on intervening in the IUC's hearing on the CIPCO power station.

Katie Madden, 27206 Allens Grove Rd, Donahue, addressed the board, via online, to intervene on the hearing for the CIPCO power station.

Brian Baxter and Amy Novak presented on the Quad-City Symphony Orchestra and St. Ambrose building proposal. Baxter presented a collaborative effort for a transformative learning center including teaching classrooms and a performing arts space. Novak presented the new center would be located on 2nd and 3rd Street of downtown Davenport.

County Auditor Kerri Tompkins reviewed a one (1) year agreement renewal for Election Systems & Software (ES&S) for \$51,229.33.

Planning and Development Director Greg Schaapveld reviewed the Second and final reading of an ordinance to amend Chapter 6 of the Scott County Code of Ordinances, to amend the zoning map to rezone a 37.07 acre +/- parcel in Section 2 of Buffalo Township, from the current "A-G" Agricultural-General designation to the "C-2" Commercial and Light Industrial designation. Schaapveld reviewed different ways the public was notified and that there was no public comment received.

County Engineer Angie Kersten reviewed an approval for a federal funding agreement between Scott County and the Iowa DOT for 85th Avenue bridge replacement project. Kersten reviewed a letting date of March 2027.

Kersten reviewed an approval for a federal funding agreement between Scott County and the Iowa DOT for Big Rock Road (Y4E) bridge replacement project. Kersten reviewed a scheduled date for a February 2027 letting.

Kersten reviewed an award of contracts for three (3) Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Resurfacing Projects. She reviewed Manatt's Inc. with the winning bid of five (5) bids for \$1,711,980.34.

Fleet Manager Mark Garrow, reviewed the purchase of one (1) Tandem Axle Plow Truck Chassis for Secondary Roads from Ascendance Truck Centers in the amount of \$169,656.00. Garrow reviewed that asset #5722 was recently totaled in an

accident and will be sold at public auction. Garrow and County Engineer Angie Kersten reviewed with the Board the importance of replacing the truck, Ascendance Truck Center, deductible with insurance, and timelines of delivery.

Garrow reviewed the purchase of one (1) Tandem Axle Plow Truck Body with snow equipment package for Secondary Roads from Henderson Products, Inc. for \$151,133.22. Garrow reviewed that asset #5722 was recently totaled in an accident and will be sold at public auction.

Human Resources Director Vanessa Wierman reviewed the over hire of a Risk Manager for one (1) week. Wierman reviewed the overlap is for training and transition of the new Risk Manager.

Wierman reviewed the salary structure adjustment for Deputy Lieutenants to reflect a percentage of the Sheriff's salary.

Community Services Director Lori Elam reviewed an approval of the Assisted Outpatient Treatment (AOT) program contract with the Iowa Primary Care Association (IPCA) to fund Scott County AOT in the amount of \$148,462.00. Elam reviewed the collaboration of local community support to identify fifteen (15) individuals to begin the program with a treatment team.

Director of Budget and Administrative Services David Farmer reviewed the Scott County and Scott County Public Safety Authority Continuing Disclosure Requirements. Farmer reviewed County Policy 13, Tax Compliance Procedures relating to Tax-Exempt Bonds.

Farmer reviewed financial policy updates. He reviewed Human Resources policy 20 T. He reviewed General Policies, 10, 11, 13, 26, and 33.

Sharma reviewed two (2) liquor license renewals. Dollar General #30307, Class "B" Retail, 13932 110th Avenue, Davenport and Pride of the Wapsi, Special Class "B" Native Retail Wine, 14600 305th Street, Long Grove.

County Administrator Mahesh Sharma opened a discussion regarding intervention on Central Iowa Power Cooperative (CIPCO) proposal before the Iowa Utilities Commission (IUC). Planning and Development Director Greg Schaapveld reviewed a current timeline and status on the docket proposed to the IUC. The Board of Supervisors agreed unanimously to intervene.
