The Board of Supervisors met as a committee of the whole and pursuant to adjournment with Paustian, Beck, Dickson, and Maxwell present. Bribiesco joined online.

County Administrator Mahesh Sharma reviewed Item #3 would be presented at 9:00 a.m.

Scott County Youth Justice & Rehabilitation Center Jeremy Kaiser reviewed the Restorative Justice Program "Auto Theft Accountability" for youth through a contract with the Iowa Judicial Branch, 7th district Juvenile Court Services. Supervisors Beck and Bribiesco reviewed with Kaiser the success of the program since 2018.

County Engineer Angela Kersten reviewed General Policy 36 – Private Drainage Construction and General Policy 41 – Special Assessment Policy Relating to the Rehabilitation of Roadways within Urbanized Areas.
