The Board of Supervisors met pursuant to adjournment with Beck and Dickson present. Bribriesco, and Maxwell joined online. Paustian was absent. The Board recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Moved by Beck, seconded by Bribriesco a motion approving the minutes of the June 14, 2026 Committee of the Whole and the June 16, 2026 Board Meeting. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Moved by Beck, seconded by Bribriesco that the following six (6) consent agenda items be approved. Roll Call: All Ayes.

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) That the Scott County Youth Justice and Rehabilitation Center will provide the Restorative Justice Program "Auto Theft Accountability" for youth through a contract with the Iowa Judicial Branch, 7th district Juvenile Court Services, ending June 30, 2027. 2) That this resolution shall take effect immediately. (168-2026)

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) General Policy 36 - Private Drainage Construction is requested to be updated with modified fees based on inflationary costs and clarification of owners and occupants shall be sent notice of a hearing. 2) General Policy 41 - Special Assessment Policy Relating to the Rehabilitation of Roadways within Urbanized Areas was amended for clarity of projects, types of improvements, and notification of special assessments. 3) This resolution shall take effect immediately. (169-2026)

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) General Policy 14 - Use of County Owned Facilities is updated to include conference and meeting rooms at Medic locations, add a medium size room category, set rental fees, minimum charges and after hours staff costs as part of Attachment B, recognizes and updates State Department name changes, and updates responsibility for background check requirements of contractors and vendors working in County facilities. 2) General Policy 21 - Posting of Material Policy is updated to reflect changes in Iowa law requiring annual Board Resolution adopting a location for posted public notices and recognizing that those notices must be visible at all times. It also returns approval of physical postings on bulletin boards and elevators to the Facility & Support Services Director to maintain consistency with approval of other physical material postings. 3) This resolution shall take effect immediately. (170-2026)

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) That the Memorandum of Understanding between Clinton County, Iowa and Scott County, Iowa for Contingency Medical Examiner and Medical Examiner Investigator Services and Coverage is hereby approved. 2) This resolution shall take effect immediately. (171-2026)

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) All 2026 Homestead Property Tax Credit and Military Property Tax Exemption Applications as recommended for allowance by the Davenport City Assessor and Scott County Assessor and as filed in the respective Assessor's Offices are hereby approved. 2) The one 2026 Homestead Property Tax Credit application

recommended for disallowance by the Davenport City Assessor is hereby disallowed. 3) The two Homestead Tax Credit applications and four Disabled Veteran Tax Credit applications recommended for disallowance by the Scott County Assessor are hereby disallowed. 4) This resolution shall take effect immediately. (172-2026)

BE IT RESOLVED: 1) The Scott County Board of Supervisors approves for payment all warrants numbered 348873 through 349206 as submitted and prepared for payment by the County Auditor, in the total amount of \$2,633,828.53. 2) The Board of Supervisors approves for payment to Wells Fargo Bank all purchase card program transactions as submitted to the County Auditor for review in the amount of \$144,121.05. 3) This resolution shall take effect immediately.
