

Scott County Board of Supervisors
August 11, 2026 8:30 a.m.

The Board of Supervisors met as a committee of the whole and pursuant to adjournment with Beck, Bribiesco, Dickson, Maxwell, and Paustian present.

Fleet Manager Mark Garrow reviewed the purchase of one (1) new and unused Model Year 2026 John Deere 324 P-Tier Compact Wheel Loader for the Secondary Roads Department from Martin Equipment through the John Deere Sourcewell cooperative purchasing contract for a total purchase price of \$143,103.64. Garrow reviewed that asset #1531, a 2012 Case721F Wheel Loader, shall be re-marketed at public auction. Supervisor Beck reviewed the size and efficiency of a new loader with the use of the current loader. Supervisor Bribiesco reviewed the bid through the Sourcewell cooperative purchasing program.

Garrow reviewed the purchase of one (1) MY27 Ram 1500 Crew Cab, 4x4 Pickup for the Sheriff's Office, from Stew Hansen Dodge City through the State of Iowa, Department of Administrative Services (DAS) Vehicle Contract Catalog for a total cost of \$53,130.59. He reviewed that existing asset #5049 will be re-marketed through public auction. Supervisor Beck reviewed with Sheriff Tim Lane the flexibility of a pickup and an interceptor.

Facility and Support Services Director Tammy Speidel reviewed the no-cost lease for Conference room E255, located at 400 W. Fourth Street Davenport, IA for a period commencing September 1, 2026, through March 1, 2027, both days inclusive. Speidel reviewed the tenants will provide their own supplies and services.

MEDIC EMS Director Paul Andorf reviewed a three-year contract agreement with the State of Iowa Health and Human Services for First Responders Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Program – Training Coordinator. Andorf reviewed the total contracted amount is \$15,000, and the end of the contract is September 29, 2028.

Community Services Director Lori Elam reviewed the FY27 grant agreement between Scott County and the Office of Drug Control Policy allowing Scott County Community Services to implement the new Assisted Outpatient Treatment program (AOT) in collaboration with Vera French CMHC and the 7th Judicial District. Elam reviewed the funding was secured through the BH-ASO contract totaling \$268,062.

Treasurer Tony Knobbe reviewed an agreement of Scott County to participate via match funding of \$200,000.00 over a four-year period to support a City of Davenport application for U.S. Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Lead Based Hazard Control and Healthy Homes Grant. Knobbe reviewed the five (5) million-dollar grant administered by the ECIA would be used to remediate homes in Davenport where both lead and children under the age of 6 were present.

Budget and Administrative Services Director David Farmer reviewed an ARPA budgetary quarterly update. David Farmer reviewed the remaining balance will be

resolved through the final invoices. He reviewed the interest earned is reimbursed to appropriate funds to support project requirements.

Moved Dickson, seconded by Beck at 9:08 a.m. a motion to close the meeting for discussion of strategy with counsel in matters that are presently in litigation or where litigation is imminent where its disclosure would likely to prejudice or disadvantage the position of the governmental body in that litigation pursuant to Iowa Code Section 21.5(1)(c). Roll Call: Four Ayes. Bribiesco Abstained.

Moved by Beck, seconded by Dickson at 10:01 a.m. a motion to reconvene in open session. Roll Call: Four Ayes. Bribiesco not present.
