The Board of Supervisors met pursuant to adjournment with Dickson, Maxwell, Paustian, Beck, and Bribiesco present. The Board recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Moved by Dickson, seconded by Beck a motion approving the minutes of the August 25, 2026 Committee of the Whole, the August 27, 2026 Board Meeting and the August 31, Special Board Meeting. Roll Call: All Ayes.

Don White, Cedar Rapids, Iowa, provided comments on renewable energy, including solar and wind farms, rural Scott County ordinances, and the use of agricultural land.
