The Board of Supervisors met as a committee of the whole and pursuant to adjournment with Maxwell, Bribiesco, and Dickson present. Paustian and Beck were absent.

County Administrator Mahesh Sharma reviewed Item #3 would be presented at 9:00 a.m.

Fleet Manager Mark Garrow reviewed with MEDIC Director Paul Andorf a purchase of one (1) replacement vehicle for MEDIC EMS from Stivers Ford for \$46,318.00. Garrow reviewed asset #5814 has met replacement criteria and will be remarketed.

Garrow reviewed with Andorf the remount of two (2) ambulances for MEDIC EMS by Klocke's Emergency Vehicles for a total of \$538,044.00. Garrow reviewed assets #5800 and #5806 are due to have their boxes remounted on new chassis.

Sheriff Tim Lane reviewed the overhire for the Sheriff's Office for one (1) full-time corrections custodial officer. Supervisor Dickson and Bribiesco reviewed with Sheriff Lane this request and staffing in the jail.
