## MINUTES PUBLIC SAFETY AUTHORITY THURSDAY, AUGUST 6, 2009 AT 6:00 P.M.

Moved by Scheibe, seconded by Drummond the Change Order #11 for Jail Contract #2 (Jail Mechanical) for Jail Expansion and Renovation Project Phase II. Dave commented that these were heating changes in the loading dock area and female housing. All ayes.

The next meeting is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, July 22, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. After the completion of construction, meetings will be scheduled on an annual basis.

Dale Barber asked how the new jail is working now that they have gotten through the initial start up problems. Dave Donovan commented that the staff really enjoys the new working conditions and the electronics are all working well.
