## Approval of Allen's Grove Boat Ramp Bid:

Verbeke-Meyer Consulting Engineers organized a bid sheet for the Board to review. Bids were received as follows: JJJ Enterprises (\$19,242.15); Kenco of Iowa (\$19,805.00) and Treiber Construction (\$19,130.00).

The DNR released about 1,200 trout into Lake of the Hills with another 400 added on Monday. He also said that it appears that the trout are surviving throughout the summer months and that since the trout release program began about 10,600 trout have been stocked at Lake of the Hills.
