The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m.

MINUTES: The minutes of the August 11, 2010 meeting were reviewed for additions and/or corrections.

MOTION: A motion was made by Ms. Fennelly to approve the minutes from the August meeting as presented, seconded by Mr. Weis, all in favor and passed.

BILLS: Reviewed for the month of August.

MOTION: A motion was made by Mr. O'Donnell to approve the bills from August as presented, seconded by Ms. McAleer, all in favor and passed.

BUSINESS:

Lake Canyada Update:

The Board was given a copy of the Agreed Order for Temporary Injunction filed by I & R Properties and Lake Canyada, LLC. The terms of the Injunction were reviewed and Mr. Kean explained that I & R Properties will be paying \$3,000/month for the next two months for maintenance expenses. After that I & R will pay on actual flow numbers taken from their flow meters until they are able to get off of our waste treatment facility.

MOTION:

A motion was made by Ms. McAleer to approve and support the conditions of the Agreed Order for Temporary Injunction filed by I & R Properties and Lake Canyada, LLC, seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, all in favor and passed.

Approval of Resolution for Winter Road Closures at Scott County Park:

The closures would be from November 1st through April 1st each year. The road affected is not used by the public during winter months thereby eliminating unnecessary maintenance expenses.

MOTION:

A motion was made by Ms. Fennelly to approve the Resolution for Winter Road Closures at Scott County Park, seconded by Mr. Weis, all in favor and passed.

Approval of Resolution for elimination of reduced speed limit by Indian Hills and the Pool and implementation of two Roadway Crossings at Scott County Park. This Resolution will eliminate the current 15 mph zone in front of the Pool and Indian Hills area. Pedestrian and Trail Crossing signs will be put up to identify and warn motorists in these areas.

MOTION:

A motion was made by Mr. O'Donnell to approve the Resolution Changing the Current Posted Speed Limits at Scott County Park, seconded by Mr. Weis, all in favor and passed.

Approval of Olde St. Anne's Church at Pioneer Village siding quote:

Out of six contractors, only Brus Construction, LLC submitted a bid. Staff recommended using the bid price for vinyl siding.

A motion was made by Mr. O'Donnell to approve Brus Construction, LLC bid of \$25,732.53 for vinyl siding at Olde St. Anne's Church, Pioneer Village, seconded by Ms. McAleer, all in favor and passed.

Approval of Personnel Lift Bid:

Out of six contractors only two bids were received for the JLG-T500J Electric Lift. Staff recommended going with the low bid from Sunbelt Rentals. The other bid was from Altorfer Inc., Davenport in the amount of \$35,883.38.

A motion was made by Ms. Fennelly to approve Sunbelt Rentals' bid of \$33,557.08 for the JLG-T500J Electric Lift, seconded by Mr. O'Donnell, all in favor and passed.
