BUSINESS:

Approval of Special Event Application from the Quad Cities Bicycle Club at Scott County Park on June 13, 2021:

QCBC is requesting to use Scott County Park's Buffalo Bill Shelter and restrooms as a rest stop during their annual club event. Staff recommended approval of the event subject to the provisions of the Special Event Permit.

MOTION:

A motion was made by Mr. Grenier to approve the Special Event Application for the Quad Cities Bicycle Club event at SCP subject to the stipulations of the Special Event Permit which includes \$75 in shelter rental fees, seconded by Ms. Fennelly, all in favor and passed.

Approval of Request by Piranhas and Davenport Metro Swim Clubs to use Scott County Park Pool for the summer of 2021 swim practices

This is a yearly request from the swim club and staff recommended approval. A fee of \$150 for each practice session will be charged and billed to the swim club at the end of the season.
