Approval of Special Event Application from Hand in Hand for their Summer Camp Event(s) at Scott County Park July 6th thru 10th and 13th thru 17th:

Camp Hand in Hand is a two-week summer program that allows kids with disabilities the opportunity to have the same summer experiences as typically developing children. The camp serves about 35 children/week and should not impact the normal use of the area. This is the fifth year for this event at Scott County Park, and staff recommends approval.

Approval of Demolition Quote for the Wapsi Center Redtail Lodge:

Staff presented bids received for the WEC-Redtail Lodge demolition project. Two bids were received: Engelbrecht Land Improvement Inc. in the amount of \$26,085 and Billy Grunwald in the amount of \$30,000. Staff recommended awarding the project to Engelbrecht Land Improvement Inc.
