They have several worksheets to complete before the next meeting. Parts of the plan will mimic the City of Davenport's mitigation plan. Amy has completed the AAR for the March 4 exercise.

SCEMSA/PAB Report

Brian Jacobsen is searching for a facilitator for the Strategic Planning Initiative process. Linda reported that the EMS Management and Billing Conference will be held in West Des Moines on April 29th, where they will discuss the new HIPPA and Red Flag rules. Denny reported they are in the process of applying for next years Training Grant monies, which at this point, looks like it will be more than last year. Linda stated from the Bureau of EMS perspective it is a direct reflection of Scott County and the good job they do applying for and using the grant monies. They are going to take money from other counties that do not apply for and use their money and give it to the counties that do. The protocols that were discussed were creating a Prehospital Hypothermia Induction Protocol and creating a School Bus Crash Protocol. Chuck also gave a demonstration of the LUCAS device that was demonstrated at the last PAB meeting.
