Minutes of the July 30 Meeting

Homeland Security/EMA/IMT Report

Discussion: Jerry Shirk

Jerry reported that the Rock Island County Citizens Core established a volunteer registration team which received funds from the Illinois Citizens Core. SECC Report

Discussion: Brian Hitchcock

Brian reported that the building project is moving forward. It appears the contractor will tentatively hand the building over on December 6th which will allow the electronics to begin being installed. Gloria Fitzpatrick continues to work on the CAD/RMS System and meet with the Build Teams. A vendor/contractor meeting has been set for October 13th to establish installation time lines of various equipment. Mike Becker has been hired as the Quality Assurance & Training Manager.

Hospital/Health Care Report

Pam reported that the Quad City Marathon will be September 26th. This year they made a course change. Adam reported that they have Flu Shot Clinics scheduled.

Discussion on handling guns during a routine medical call came up. Some of the issues that arise are gun handling training, storage of the gun, chain of custody of the gun and the procedure for a conscious patient versus an unconscious patient. With the January 1st verbiage change in Iowa Code for counties to issue permits to carry weapons from "may to shall" it is expected the number of permit applications will drastically rise in all counties.

Denny reported they are currently in the process of working on their Work Plan that needs to be submitted by September 30th. Denny added with the new grant requirement that Special Needs Population will be added to the standing agenda to meet the new grant deliverable.
