Discussion:

Minutes of the 9-28 and 10-26 Meetings

Discussion:

Motion to approve the September 28th and October 26th meeting minutes was seconded and approved unanimously.

Homeland Security/EMA/IMT Report

Discussion:

Ross Bergen announced the upcoming nuclear power plant exercise will be evaluated by FEMA on December 5th. He explained that press releases were sent out regarding Potassium Iodide (KI) distribution in Iowa and Illinois and that the state of Illinois has decided to distribute KI to those residents in the EPA zone, but the state of Iowa will not. Amy Cannady shared that concerned citizens have already been calling the Health Department. Lastly, Ross announced that PIO training will be held on Monday at SECC for those interested. Jerry Shirk reminded the group that Augustana will be holding an active shooter tabletop exercise on December 17th and volunteers are welcome. Bethaney Conklin shared that they held an active shooter exercise for the DeWitt school district which allowed for Genesis to test their surge capacity in the ER.

SECC Report

Discussion:

Brian Hitchcock reported they are continuing to complete installation work on the Backup Center and Storage Facility. They continue to wait on the Communications Trailer. Lastly, narrowbanding has been completed for the County.

Hospital/Healthcare Planning Report

Discussion:

Bethaney Conklin announced that Clinton County will be hosting ICS 300 and 400 trainings in the near future if other parties are interested. Denny will send out an email with the dates of the trainings. Trent Mull stated that IEMA training was held earlier this week on radiation response. He also stated that Genesis, Trinity and the Health Department have been meeting to form a healthcare coalition for Scott County.

Public Health Planning Report

Discussion:

Nita Ludwig from the Rock Island County Health Department shared that their two objectives for the grant year include fatality and volunteer management plans. Lastly, Denny Coon announced that the Health Department, Genesis and Trinity participated in an IDPH webinar to complete a healthcare coalition questionnaire requested by the feds.

EMS Report-IEMSA Conference

Discussion:

Brian Jacobsen reported their last meeting was a joint meeting with the Fire Chiefs. Through the Scott County Regional Authority Fall Grant Cycle they received money to complete the pager upgrades and one LUCAS device. Linda Frederiksen shared that Wheatland Ambulance will have some predicted coverage gaps in their schedule beginning January 1, 2013. They will be getting mutual aid contracts together for surrounding ambulance agencies to ensure they have coverage. Linda added the IAEMSA Annual Conference and Tradeshow on November 8 – 10 was well attended. Lastly, EMS Day on the Hill is scheduled for January 31st. Sue Vallejo shared a picture of their three new ambulances at the Rock Island Fire Department. Chris Webster reported all Genesis ambulances now have LUCAS devices on both the Iowa and Illinois side of the river. He also shared that LifeNet is being installed at the Illini campus in the next couple of weeks.

Steve Knorrek reported that they are in the process of planning various trainings to be offered this winter. Lynn Washburn-Livingston shared at their last meeting the Fire Chief's spent the bulk of the meeting test driving the new RMS system and looking at how it can benefit all Scott County Fire Departments in providing a consistent system everyone is working with.
