March 17 Vaccination Clinic

The Iowa Department of Public Health has given Scott County another extra allocation of 1,170 doses of Pfizer vaccine for administration this week. A one-day vaccination clinic is scheduled for Wednesday, March 17. The clinic will take place at the former Sears department store, Scott County's vaccination clinic site. Registration for this clinic is for:

- Individuals 65+ years of age
- Individuals with disabilities and their attendant care staff (includes family member if providing attendant care)
- Individuals 64 years of age and younger with <u>medical conditions</u> that put them at an increased risk for severe COVID-19 illness
- Healthcare workers
- PreK-12th grade school staff, early childhood educators, childcare workers

Individuals are asked to bring form of personal identification.
