Dr. Keppy, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 12:00 Noon. The Recording Secretary took the roll call. All members were present with the exception of Dr. Garvin, who arrived at 12:11 p.m.

Larry Barker introduced the new Resource Assistant, Tracie Bernhard, to the Board.

Dr. Sunderbruch expressed concerns that firemen are the first responder to all 9ll calls, and in some cases that might not be appropriate.

Dr. Sunderbruch stated that the report from Carol Schnyder and Amy Thoreson on the Second Annual Public Health Information Network (PHIN) Stakeholders' Conference was very valuable.

Larry Barker reported that he is concerned that we have been unable to successfully recruit nurses to work in Correctional Health Services.

Roma Taylor reported to the Board on the eleven recent cases of Pertussis that have been reported. Dr. Katz asked that a letter be sent to all physicians advising them to be on the lookout for cases.

Larry Barker reported that the Department received a letter and a certificate from the Iowa Department of Public Health for having achieved an immunization rate of over 90%. The Scott County Health Department is at 95%.
