Dr. Keppy, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 12:00 Noon. The Recording Secretary took the roll call. All members were present with the exception of Dr. Garvin, who arrived at 12:18 p.m.

This meeting is the annual meeting with the Scott County Board of Supervisors. Carol Schaefer, Chairman of the Board of Supervisors and Ray Wierson, County Administrator, gave a presentation on the Jail Facilities Solution.

Ray Wierson, County Administrator, presented a video on the Jail.

Dr. Louis Katz, Scott County Health Department Medical Director, gave an update on Influenza.

Dr. Katz had with him a delegation of nine visitors from Russia, who are here to discuss and compare approaches in dealing with the HIV epidemic, as well as other public

health issues.

1. Director's Report of September – October , 2004, activities.

Larry Barker introduced the two new Public Health Nurses, Driesst McAdams and Jodie Collins to the Board. They are working in the Jail Health Services program.
