

COVID-19 Vaccine Information



Iowa child care providers are included in Phase 1B, Tier 1 which will begin in February. What should you do now? Remain patient. In Scott County, local public health is vaccinating individuals in Phase 1B, Tier 1, as vaccine supply allows.

Monitor the Iowa Department of Public Health COVID-19 vaccine web page for updated information, and additional resources https://idph.iowa.gov/Emerging-Health-Issues/Novel-Coronavirus/Vaccine.

Also monitor information from your local public health for updates on accessing vaccine at the local level. Check emails (including your spam folder) as local public health working with other partners (CCNCs,

CCR&R agencies) will send out information to child care providers to assess the number of providers needing vaccination. In Scott County, a survey was sent in January and the department will work directly with child care providers to schedule vaccine appointments.

Call your Child Care Nurse Consultant (CCNC) if you have any questions about child health and safety, or any special training

needs.
