National Infant Immunization Week April 24 – May 1, 2021

National Infant Immunization Week highlights the importance of protecting children two years and younger from vaccine-preventable diseases. This year, in particular, it's critical to ensure that families stay on track with routine well child checkups and recommended vaccinations — even during COVID-19.

A Centers for Disease Control (CDC) report released in May 2020 found a troubling drop in routine childhood vaccination as a result of families staying at home. CDC and the American Academy of Pediatrics recommend that children stay on track with their well-child appointments and routine vaccinations even during the pandemic. As learning and play in-person increases, on-time vaccination is even more urgent to help provide immunity against 14 serious diseases.

World Autism Month

Autism spectrum disorder (ASD) is a developmental disability that can cause significant social, communication and behavioral challenges. According to the CDC, about 1 in 54 children has been identified with autism. ASD is more than 4 times more common among boys than among girls. Early signs of ASD can include:

- Avoiding eye contact
- Having little interest in other children or caretakers
- Limited display of language (for example, having fewer words than peers or difficulty with use of words for communication)
- Getting upset by minor changes in routine
