National Public Health Month

April marks the celebration of National Public Health month. This year's theme of "Public Health is ROI: Save Lives. Save Money", combines two common threads, public health and prevention.

Much like the business world, "ROI" indicates the "return on investments". Supporting evidence-based public health programs will result in healthier communities and reduced cost in treating diseases.

The U.S. spends far more on health care than any other country. However, investing just \$10 per person each year in proven, community-based public health efforts could save the nation more than \$16 billion within five years. That's a \$5.60 return for every \$1 invested! As you can see "Public Health is ROI: Save Lives, Save Money"

This year's theme includes 5 weeks of awareness:

Did you know? For every \$1 invested in workplace wellness programs, medical costs drop by more than \$3.

Did you know?

About two-thirds of home fire deaths happened in homes

without working smoke alarms. Smoke alarms can double your chance of surviving a fire.

Providing a Safe Environment for **Children at School**

Did you know?

Routine childhood immunizations

save 33,000

lives, prevent 14 million cases of disease and save \$9.9 million in direct health care costs annually. Every dollar spent on childhood immunizations alone saves \$18.40.

Protecting You While You're on the Move

Did you know? Motor vehicle-related injuries are the leading cause of death among



U.S. children. A \$52 car seat can prevent \$2,200 in medical costs, that's \$42 for every \$1 invested.

Empowering a Healthy Community

Did you know?

Tobacco use is responsible for more than 400,000 U.S. deaths every year. The benefits of smoking



cessation programs nearly always outweigh the costs and ranges from 86 cents to more than \$2.50 for every \$1 invested.

As you can see, public health surrounds you every day, in many ways. It is with you at work, home, school, and at play. Public health is about prevention and protection. It encourages us to live healthier, and to learn more about how

childhood vaccinations can prevent the spread of disease in our community.
