The State of Iowa Historic Society will be providing the "Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation." These guidelines apply to interior and exterior work as well as new exterior additions.

The Davenport Historic Preservation Commission utilizes the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation and the City's Historic Preservation Ordinance when reviewing modifications to existing structures or proposing new structures to properties listed on the Davenport Register of Historic Properties.
