

December 8, 2011 from 4 p.m.-6 p.m. The
training will be held at the Davenport Police
Department Conference Room, which is located
at 416 North Harrison St., Davenport.

The State of Iowa Historic Society will be
providing the “Secretary of the Interior’s
Standards for Rehabilitation.” These guidelines
apply to interior and exterior work as well as
new exterior additions.

The Davenport Historic Preservation
Commission utilizes the Secretary of the
Interior’s Standards for Rehabilitation and the
City’s Historic Preservation Ordinance when
reviewing modifications to existing structures or
proposing new structures to properties listed on
the Davenport Register of Historic Properties.
This is a wonderful opportunity for the Historic
Preservation Commission to brush up on its
knowledge and for elected and appointed
officials, city staff and members of the public to
better understand how the Commission reviews
proposals. This training will also benefit
members of the public seeking to rehabilitate
their property in a historic appropriate manner.
