Dr. Maryan Wherry will speak about the creation of Black Hawk Park in Rock Island by the CCC (Civilian Conservation Corps) and decorated by the WPA (Works Project Agency). She has Master's degrees in History and English and a PhD in American Culture Studies.

Black Hawk Park has a wonderful small museum dedicated to the CCC and we will visit it in conjunction to the presentation.

In 1933, Franklin Delano Roosevelt created the public work relief program known as the Civilian Conservation Corps. The "CCC boys" were to perform desperately needed conservation work on the nation's forests and farms.

From 1933 to 1935 a camp of the Civilian Conservation Corps was located at Black Hawk State Park. Camp Black Hawk employed more than two hundred veterans of World War I in exchange for clothing, room, board and a dollar a day.

There are many CCC projects in our area, i.e., the levee, streets in downtown Davenport, the shop building at VanderVeer Park, and Devil's Glenn Park in Bettendorf.
